



## **NASA EPSCoR CAN ISS Flight Opportunity FY2019 Request for Pre-Proposals**

We anticipate that NASA will issue an EPSCoR Cooperative Agreement Notice (CAN) announcement for an ISS Flight Opportunity on or about September 16, 2019. It is expected that there will be an opportunity for Delaware to submit one proposal for potential funding under this CAN. Based on previous funding levels, we anticipate awards to be for three years at \$100,000 each, with no cost share requirement.

All interested researchers at Delaware institutions of higher education are invited to submit a pre-proposal that will be used to determine which full proposal will be submitted to NASA for the 2019 competition. The full proposal will be expected to establish research activities that will make significant contributions to NASA's strategic research and technology development priorities and contribute to the overall research infrastructure, science and technology capabilities, higher education, and economic development of the jurisdiction.
