



NASA EPSCoR CAN Suborbital Flight Opportunity FY 2021 Request for Pre-Proposals

NASA has released an EPSCoR Cooperative Agreement Notice (CAN) announcement, via an amendment, for a Suborbital Flight Opportunity. Delaware is eligible to submit one proposal for potential funding under this CAN. Awards will be up to three years and up to \$200,000 each, with no cost share requirement.

All interested researchers at Delaware institutions of higher education are invited to submit a pre-proposal that will be used to determine which full proposal will be submitted to NASA for this year's competition. The full proposal will be expected to establish research activities that will make significant contributions to NASA's strategic research and technology development priorities and contribute to the overall research infrastructure, science and technology capabilities, higher education, and economic development of the jurisdiction.

If interested in the Suborbital Flight Opportunity, please plan to submit a 1-page pre-proposal to the attention of Delaware's NASA EPSCoR Director at desgc@bartol.udel.edu by **December 16, 2020**.

It is anticipated that one pre-proposal will be selected by **January 4, 2021**. If selected, the proposal will be due to NASA **February 22, 2021**.
